EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES AT THE VEERNI INSTITUTE AND THE VEERNI BALIKA CENTRE

- Academic Focus: To ensure success in their upcoming board exams, additional classes for classes 10th and 12th commenced on January 2nd. These classes provided extra support and focused revision for the crucial exams.
- On January 14th, class 10th students presented their science projects before the Matrons and classmates. This not only helped them delve deeper into their subjects but also boosted their confidence in public speaking and group work.
- Board classes received a revised timetable, prioritizing study time for their upcoming exams.
- Making the Most of Break Time: Even with government holidays from January 14th to 17th, the school prioritized student learning. To enhance their skills and solidify theoretical knowledge, Class 11 science girls participated in practical physics, chemistry, and biology sessions during this break.
- **Practical Exams:** Practical exams were held for grades 10, 11, and 12 in Physics, Geography, Biology, and Chemistry.
- **Pre-Board Exams:** Pre-board exams were conducted for grades 5, 8, 10, and 12 to assess learning and identify areas for improvement.
- Unit Tests: Unit tests were held for grades 4, 6, 7, 9, and 11.
- **Daily Classes:** Our students will attend regular classes at Modern Senior Secondary School from 7:30 AM to 1:30 PM.
- Extra Classes: Veerni Institute and Veerni Balika Centre will continue to offer supplementary tuition classes to reinforce learning.
- Online Support: Senior girls in grades 9 to 12 at Veerni Institute benefit from a wellequipped Smart classroom. This space hosts online lectures to provide additional academic support.
- Computer Skill: Qualified computer teachers will lead daily computer classes at both institutes, equipping girls with essential digital skills. In addition, class 11th girls received extra computer education, equipping them with valuable digital skills.

Annual Examination Update:

- Exams for Board Classes 12th, 10th, and 8th began on March 4th, 7th, and 28th, respectively. We wish all our students the very best in their exams!
- Exams for Grades 6th and 7th were held last week of March.
- · Grade 9th and 11th exams are scheduled for April. Specific dates will be announced soon.

An Educational Trip to the Central Arid Zone Research Centre, Jodhpur

On January 4th, Veerni girls from grades 10-12 embarked on an exciting educational tour to the Central Arid Zone Research Centre. This trip aimed to broaden their knowledge horizons and expose them to the fascinating world of scientific innovation in agriculture.

Veerni believes that such field trips are invaluable for our girls. They not only gain firsthand experience with the latest agricultural practices and technologies but also discover the vast career opportunities within this critical sector. The visit sparked curiosity in the girls, as they learned about cultivating unique crops like mushrooms and "jewellery plants," alongside various other crop varieties.

The exposure to diverse agricultural practices and career paths may very well inspire some of our girls to pursue higher education and careers in science and agriculture. Overall, this enriching trip provided a valuable learning experience that will stay with the girls for a long time.









HEALTH CARE ACTIVITIES

We are fortunate to have a dedicated medical team led by Dr. A.S. Deora. Dr. Deora visits the institute weekly to provide comprehensive medical care to the girls. Our in-house nurse, Mrs. Vimlesh Sharma, is available daily to address any immediate needs and ensure the girls' continued health. Additionally, Mrs. Syiona Kalasua lends valuable support as a volunteer.

To ensure personalized care, each girl has a comprehensive health card that tracks their medical history and treatment plans. This collaborative approach guarantees that all our girls receive the best possible medical attention and support they need to thrive.





Health Camp

On January 15th, 2024, Veerni partnered with School Health Pro, a well-respected organization dedicated to improving student health and well-being, to conduct a special health camp exclusively for our 110 girls at Veerni Sansthan, Jodhpur. School Health Pro is distinguished by its team of highly motivated and specialized doctors from the esteemed All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), ensuring our girls received the highest quality of care.

The health camp was meticulously organized by the School Health Pro team, who brought in a complete setup of medical equipment to facilitate a comprehensive range of screenings. These screenings included anthropometric measurements, medical examinations, ENT check-ups, ophthalmology check-ups, and dental examinations. This thorough approach provided valuable insights into the girls' overall health and well-being, allowing for early detection and intervention of any potential health concerns.

The dedication of the entire Veerni Sansthan team to the well-being of the students truly impressed the School Health Pro team. This commitment was evident through the good nutritional status of the majority of students, as indicated by their Height, Weight, and BMI measurements. Celebrating Milestones

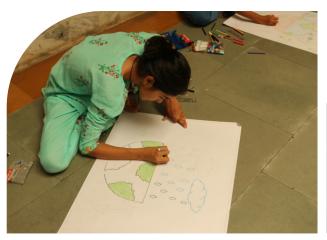

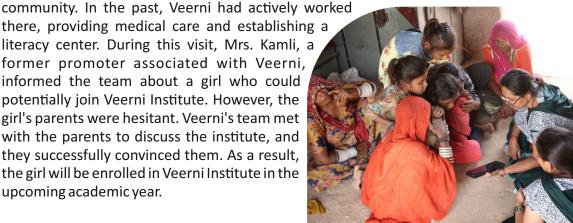




Veerni Team's Village Visit to Bhakri
